Postgraduate students, who have not submitted yet an application for undertaking a Postgraduate Diploma Thesis, are invited

1. To send this application, provided that they have passed 6 (six) courses, completed by them and signed and countersigned by the supervising professor with whom they have come to an agreement. The supervisor will also nominate the other two committee members.

The application must be sent in time to the secretariat's email (ipp\_as@mail.ntua.gr) until **30/09/2025**. Beyond this date, it will be considered overdue and will be postponed for the next Time withdrawal period (i.e. between 2/02/2026 - 13/02/2026). Note: a short extension may be exceptionally granted for special reasons.

- 2. In consultation with the supervising professor to define a Postgraduate Diploma Thesis title, even if temporary, and
- 3. Send electronically to ipp\_as@mail.ntua.gr in doc (Word) format a page with: full name, registration number (AM), supervisor's name, ME title, language and summary 5-10 lines.

**Note 1:** those who wish to have the ME written in English, note this on the application together with the title of the Postgraduate Diploma Thesis also in English. **Important Note:** Those who admitted to the Master's Program **in the 2024-2025** Academic Year must write their Postgraduate Diploma Thesis in English.

**Note 2:** Those who intend to apply for an extension of studies in October 2025 for one semester, should be aware that the condition of having taken Postgraduate Diploma Thesis is valid.
